

ORDINANCE NO. 277

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 132.25 OF THE  
TULAROSA CODE OF ORDINANCES PROVIDING FOR  
UNLAWFUL DRINKING IN PUBLIC OR BEING  
INTOXICATED IN PUBLIC PLACES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE VILLAGE OF  
TULAROSA, NEW MEXICO:

That Section 132.25 of the Tularosa Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to  
read as follows:

132.25 (A). DRINKING IN PUBLIC PLACES. Drinking in public places  
consists of drinking or consuming alcoholic liquors, as the term  
is defined in NMSA 60-3A-3 et seq., as amended, in or on any  
public place including public parks, private club, key club,  
whether operated for profit or not, or on a parking lot adjacent  
to an establishment licensed to dispense alcoholic liquors;  
provided, that this section shall not apply to drinking inside  
an establishment having a license to dispense alcoholic liquors.

(B). PUBLIC INTOXICATION. It is unlawful for any person to  
be intoxicated by any drug or alcohol in any public place as set  
forth above.

(C). Any person convicted of public intoxication shall be  
given a notice of trespass pursuant to Section 134.04 (B) of the  
Tularosa Code of Ordinances prohibiting trespass in any park  
owned or operated by the Village of Tularosa.
